Student grant to attend the 9th Balaton Symposium

In order to facilitate the presence of young scientists at the 9th Balaton Symposium on High-Performance Separation Methods, the Hungarian Society for Separation Sciences will provide grants to PhD students. Grants will be presented to PhD students who will present either an oral or poster contribution at the 9th Balaton Symposium in Siófok, Hungary. The grant consists of complimentary registration, full board including a stay for two nights (September 4 to 6, 2013) with double-bed accommodation at the Hotel Azúr, and free participation at the social programs. Travel allowance will not be provided.

PhD students under the age of 35 at the time of the application deadline are eligible. PhD students from all over the world may apply; applications from Central and Eastern Europe are encouraged.

Please note that a separate grant is available for the members of the Hungarian Society for Separation Sciences, who should not apply for this Student Grant.

- a letter requesting consideration for the grant,
- a resume with list of publications,
- a letter of recommendation from your advisor,
- a copy of your abstract,
- evidence of eligibility (student ID).

Deadline to apply is June 1, 2013.

The winners will be selected by the Board of the Hungarian Society for Separation Sciences and notified by June 15, 2013. The winners will be asked to write a brief meeting report (1.5 pages at most), which will be displayed on the web site of the Balaton Symposium and that of the Hungarian Society for Separation Sciences.
